- False friends

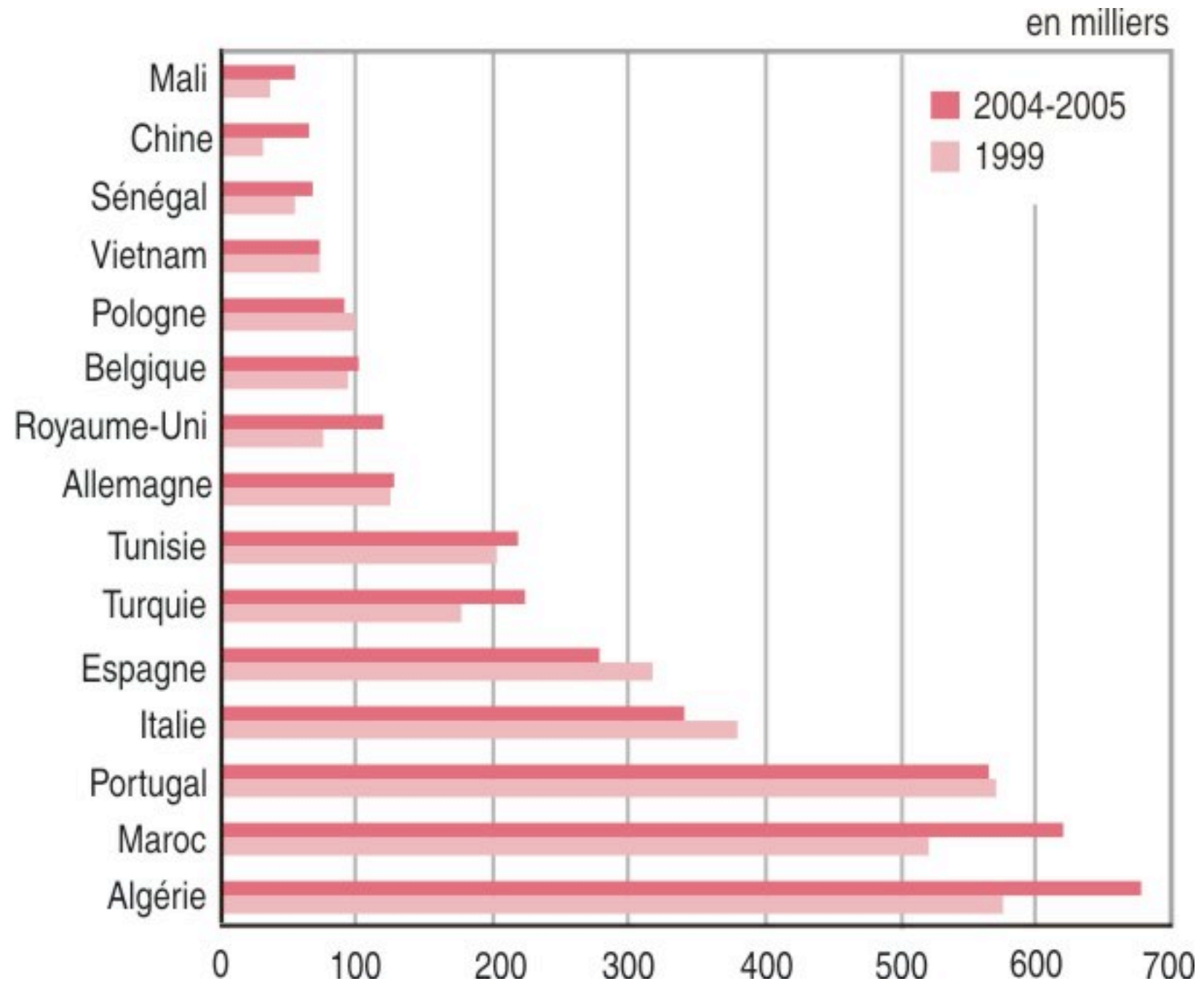
Advantages of double comparison:

The Sans-Papiers



- 400.000 persons
- 20.000 children in schools

Social and youth services

- Relatively strong position of parents (principle of co-presence)
- De-centralisation: „Departement“ and „commune“
- Big welfare organisations (church-bound) primarily in poverty and disabilities
- High proportion of personnel of non-teaching professions at school

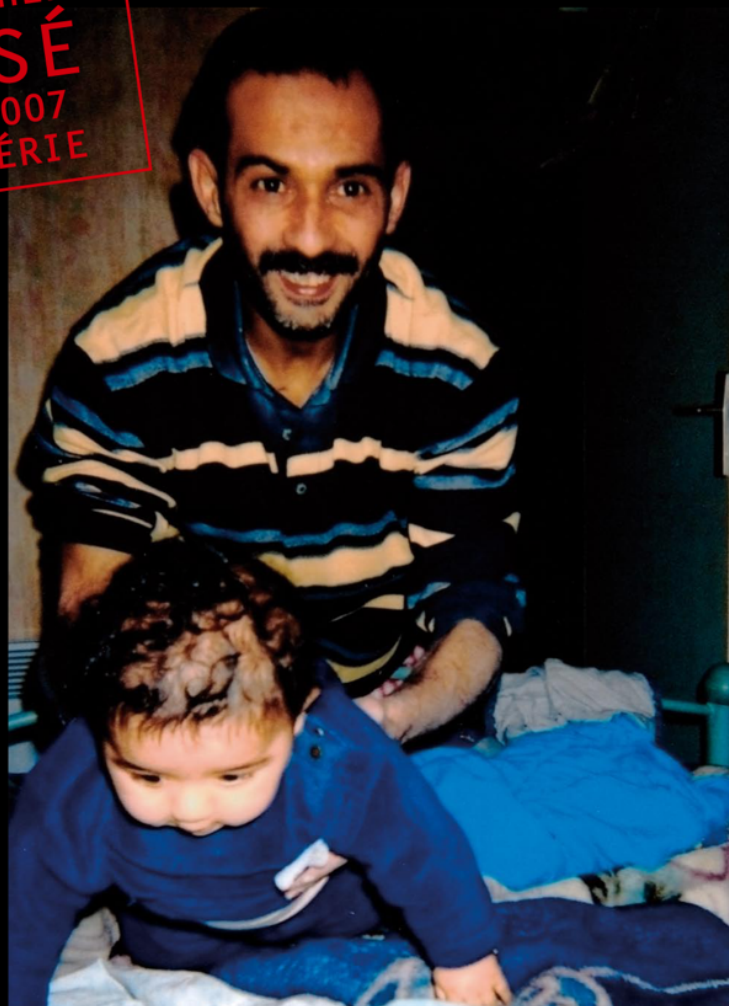
La double peine a été officiellement abolie en 2003. Cependant, Mohammed Belgherbi continue, chaque jour, d'en subir les effets.

Arrivé en France en 1988 avec des papiers en règle, Mohammed Belgherbi est le père d'une famille de 5 enfants, tous scolarisés à Marseille: Rayan (2 ans), Yamina (8 ans), Mehdi (9 ans), Ahmed (14 ans), Oualid (16 ans). À terme, tous ses enfants auront la nationalité française. Sa compagne algérienne dispose, quant à elle, d'une carte de résidence de 10 ans.

À la suite d'un passage devant les tribunaux en 1994, Mohammed Belgherbi a été doublement condamné: à une peine de prison ainsi qu'à une interdiction définitive de séjour sur le territoire français. Expulsé une première fois à sa sortie de prison en 1996, il réussit à revenir rapidement auprès de sa famille. Expulsé une seconde fois en 1998, il a mis plus de trois ans à la revoir. En 2005, il a demandé une assignation à résidence

afin de pouvoir légalement rester avec sa femme et ses enfants en France. Cette demande a été refusée.

Après un nouveau passage devant les tribunaux, Mohammed Belgherbi a été expulsé le 22 février 2007, sans bagage, vers un pays où il ne l'attendait. Il n'a pourtant



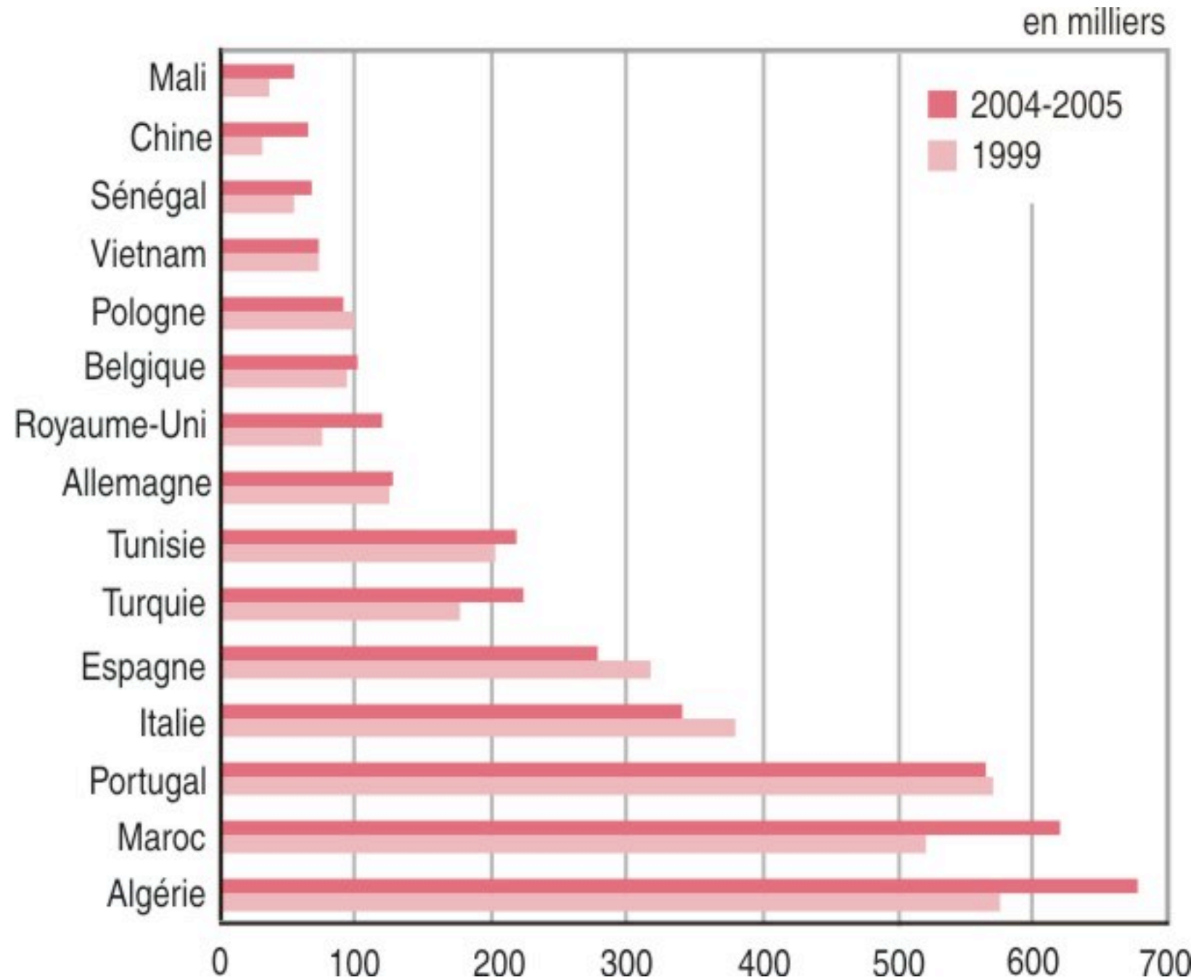

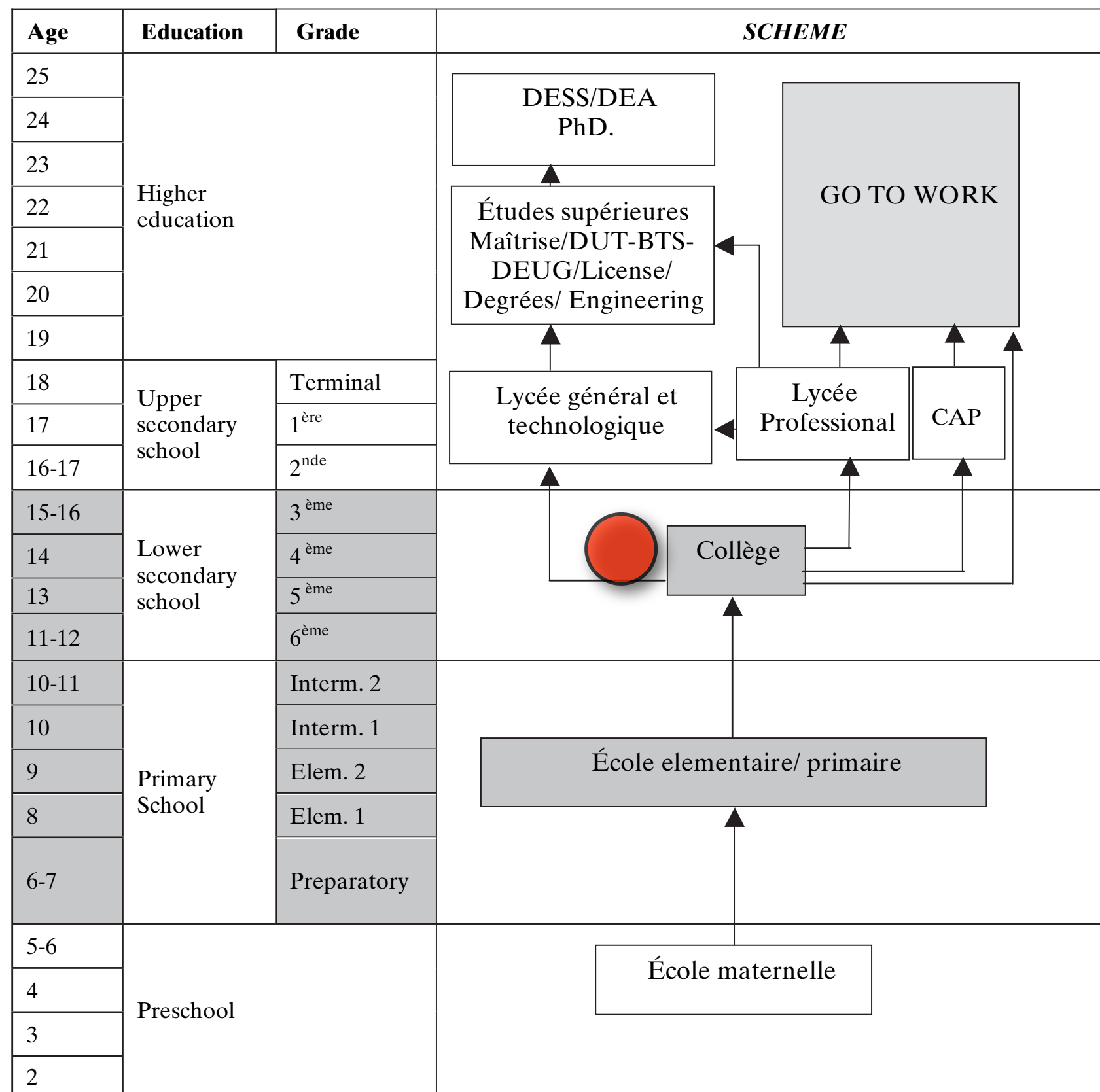

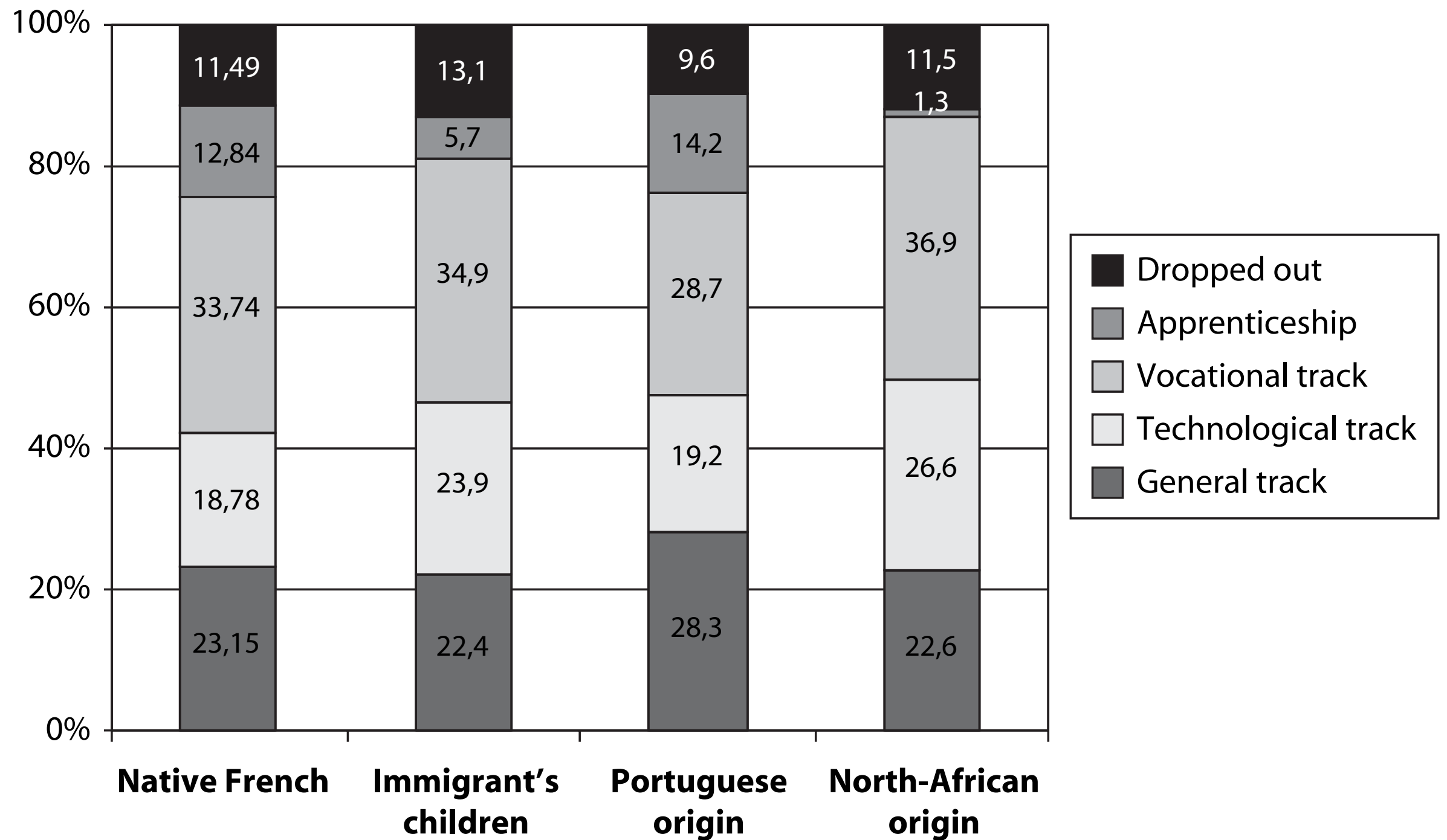


Figure 7 School situation in 2002 for lower categories (1995 cohort)

Youth unemployment rates (19-29 yrs)

- Both parents born in France: 20%
- Both parents born in Algeria or Morocco: 40%

Support for Transitions

- Since 1982: Missions Locales and PAIO (Permanence d'Accueil d'Information et d'Orientation)
- Since 1998: Nouveaux services - nouveaux emplois (emplois-jeunes) ± 300.000
- Since 1998: TRACE (TRajet d'ACcès à l'Emploi)

Integration: 4 levels

- structural
- cultural
- social
- identificative

Integration in France

- „Republican“ and universalistic mode of integration
- Objective: cultural and identificative integration
- Spatial segregation reinforced by housing policies

Particularities

- no collective minority rights,
- education and citizenship as major factors for integration (but NOT for all).
- „spatiality“ of exclusion processes

Current debates



- From „Touche pas à mon pote“ to „Touche pas à mon ADN“ („Hands off my DNA“)
- Anti-discrimination law (e.g. anonymous CV)
- „Ethnic“ statistics („What colour is your skin would you say?“)

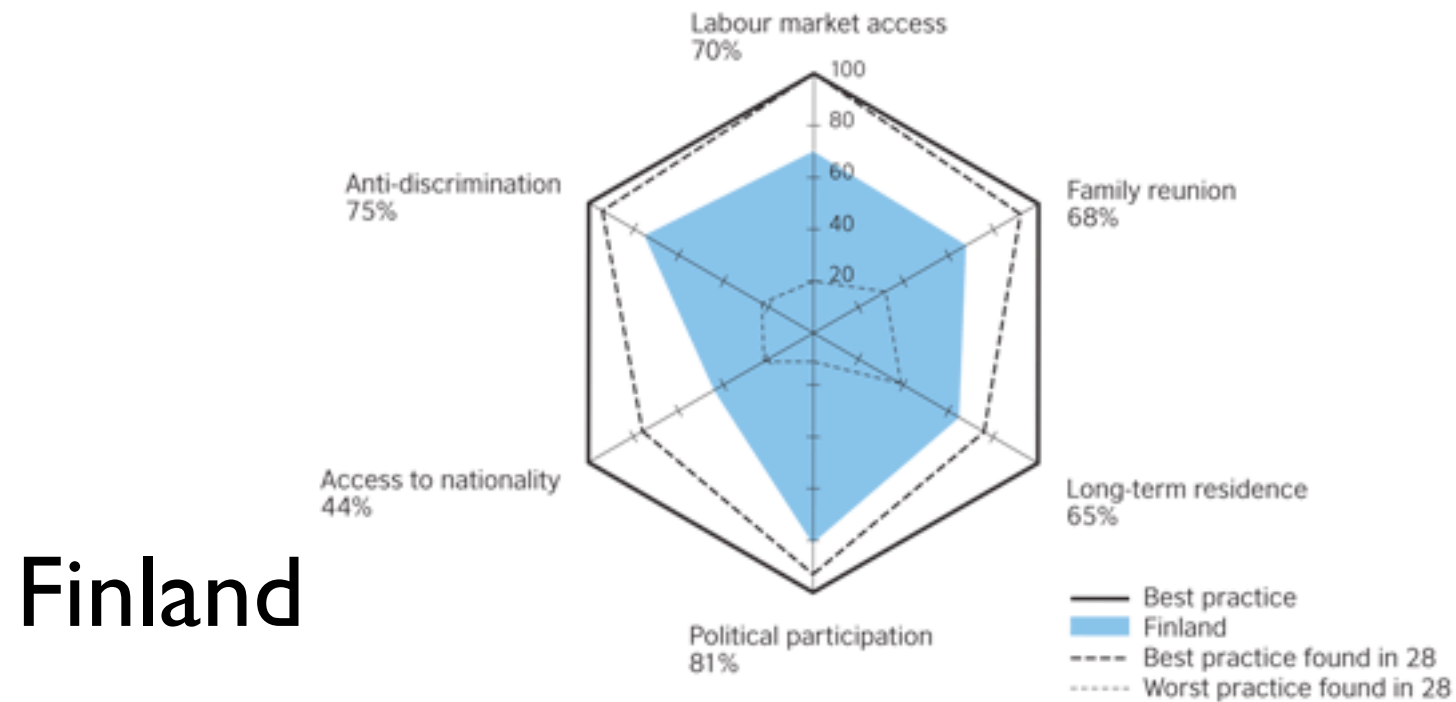
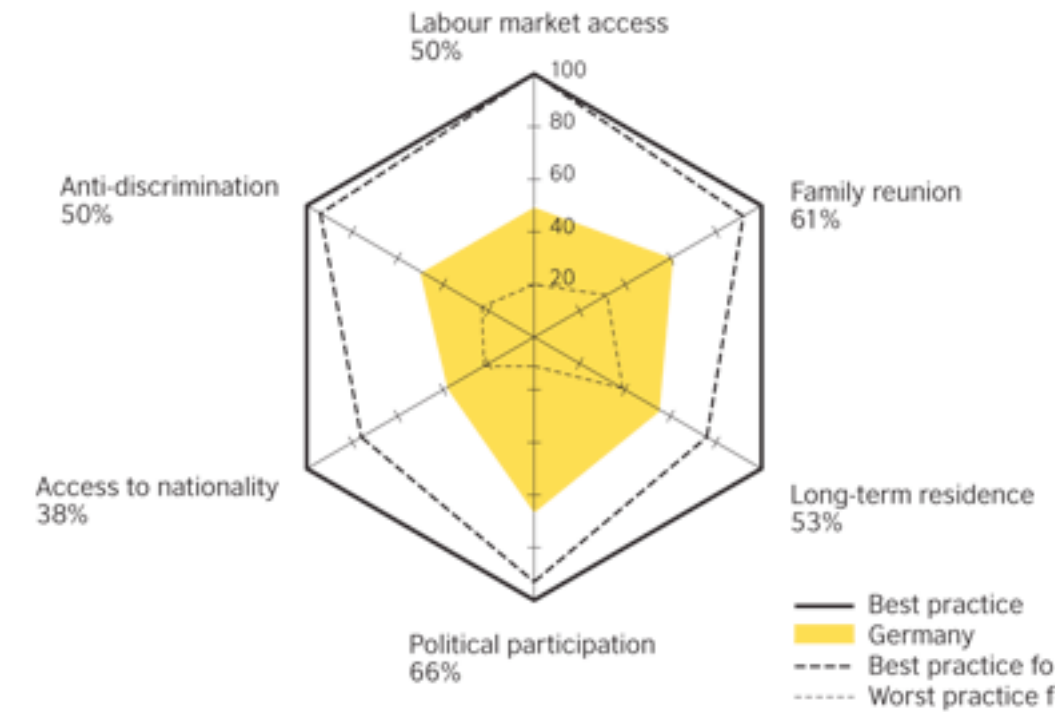
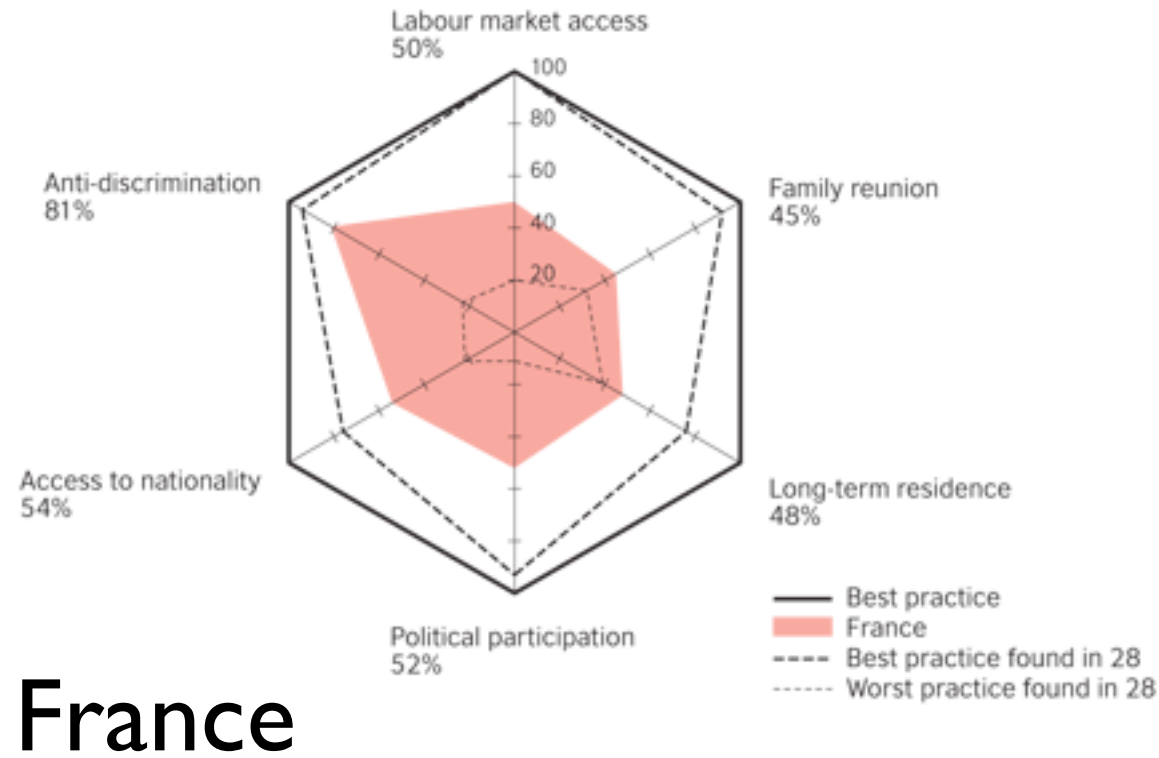
- Citizenship alone does not guarantee equal opportunities

- New role of social work from „Neo-assimilationism“

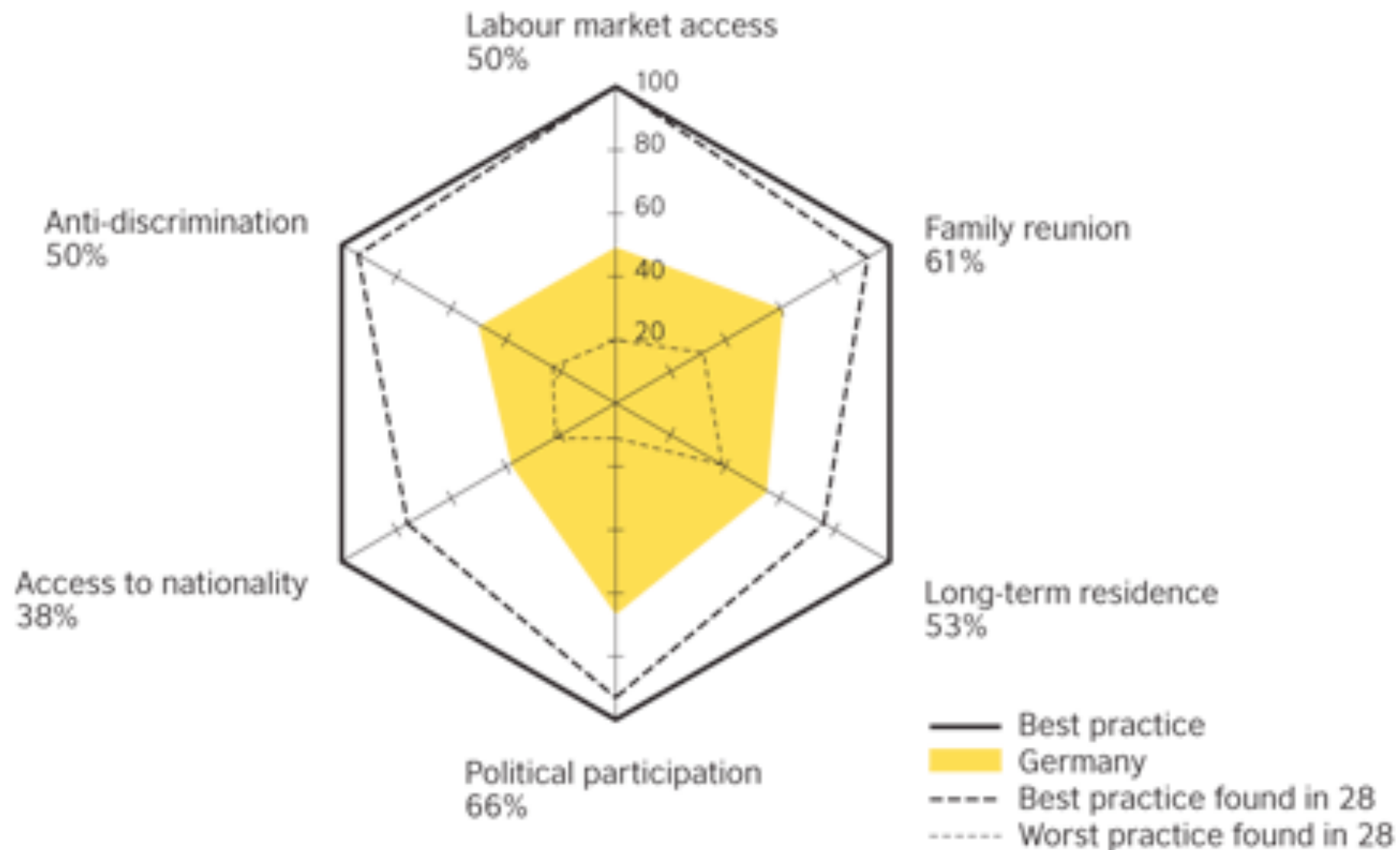
Integration efforts
